
**EXCESSIVE BLOOD ALCOHOL CLAUSE AS TO DEFENDANT BENNY JASPER**

Good morning Mr. Berson,

I hope that this email finds you well and you are still staying safe. It is that time again to have the informal readiness hearing with the judge tomorrow at 9am via Bluejeans (I will put the link at the bottom of this email).

Given the fact that COVID-19 doesn't seem to be going anywhere, the court system is still very backed up, and in the interest of trying to resolve the case I am going to make one final offer. My final offer is: Dry Reckless, 2 years CP, CTS, DUI Terms (Do not drive unless licensed and insured, do not drive with any measurable amount of alcohol in your system, submit to a chemical test upon request from a peace officer if stopped for suspicion on DUI), 12 hour Wet Reckless class, \$954 fine. This offer is only open until the trial date of 8/28.

Let me know if you are available to appear at the informal readiness tomorrow morning, otherwise I would be happy to appear for both of us and give the judge an update.
